
The final words from the Project Coordinator (CETMA)

RE⁴ project is now making the final steps of its successful journey which lasted three and a half years and it has been paved by encouraging results and large interest from the technical and general community.


RE⁴ has started in September 2016 with the ambition of contributing to the achievement of the key challenges identified by the Europe 2020 strategy, which requires EU Member States to re-use, recycle and recover a minimum of 70% by weight of non-hazardous CDW.

Now, at the beginning of 2020, RE⁴ is ready to provide innovative technologies and reliable strategies for the design and manufacturing of structural and non-structural pre-fabricated elements with high degree (up to 85%) of recycled materials and reused structures from partial or total demolition of buildings.
